Update on Electronic BDN's

The IMO have confirmed that electronic BDNs are acceptable as an alternative to the usual hard copy. The information contained remains the same and there should be systems in place to make sure the document is protected from editing and kept available onboard in case required in the same way as a hard copy BDN.
